



Old Marsh Golf Club Helpful Guest Guidelines 2021-22

The Members of Old Marsh Golf Club are dedicated to the preservation of traditional golf to be played in the friendly and natural beauty of its surroundings. In an effort to assist you with your golf while visiting Old Marsh, our professional staff has highlighted a few traditions of the Club we ask you to observe.

Arrival at Old Marsh Golf Club: In order for us to provide the finest service to our Guests, we ask that all visiting guests have their cars valet parked by the staff. Guests are asked to refrain from changing their shoes or carrying their clubs in the parking lot. Guests will be escorted by the Golf Professional Staff to the Locker Room where they must change their shoes and will receive an assigned locker for the day. All guests without the accompaniment of a Member are required to check in with the Golf Shop to receive additional information regarding their round. All golf fees and Food & Beverage fees will be billed to the sponsoring Member. However; guests wishing to purchase any merchandise in the Golf Shop may use cash or credit card.

Attire: *The dress code as applies to the Golf Course and all practice facilities.*

Gentlemen: Collared shirts are allowed and must be tucked in at all times. Golf shorts must be Bermuda length and hemmed. Baseball caps must be worn forward position and must be removed prior to entering the clubhouse. Flip Flops or other open toed shoes are not allowed.

Ladies: Golf skirts, divided skirts (skorts), tailored slacks or Bermuda shorts mid-thigh length are permitted. Women's shirts must be conservative in nature and have either sleeves or collars or both. Baseball caps and visors are not allowed in the dining room.

Cellular Phones: The use of mobile devices for texting or for use as a camera is permitted. Talking on mobile phones is prohibited on the golf course, driving range, and practice tee, as well as in the club house including the dining areas, foyer, and golf shop.

Mobile phones are permitted in the locker rooms, and on the patio areas. General decorum, including a reasonable separation from others, should be used when talking on mobile phones in their permitted areas.

Gratuities: Old Marsh Golf Club is a tipping facility. Gratuities for the outside golf staff, locker room attendants and caddies are appreciated for a job well done but certainly not expected.

Minimum Recommended Caddie Fees:

*Forecaddie Fee: \$50 per bag or \$200 for the group

*Walking Bag Fee \$100.00

**This suggested fee is the minimum fee and does not include gratuity.*

You will have at least one caddie assigned to your group. If the group is less than 4 players, a player escort may be assigned to the group, and if the group has 4 players a forecaddie will be assigned to the group.

*All charges incurred by guests for green fees, cart rental, food and refreshments will be billed to the sponsoring member or sponsoring Club.
